Lesson 1:

In this week's lesson you will dig into your customer's pain points, that will help you to identify the desirability of a new product or process, something that adds value to them and that they are willing to pay for.

Upcoming activities:

Customer interviews: Interviewing your potential users is a critical piece of the Design Thinking process. This step will help empathise with them, identify their problems and collect data against which you will compare your assumptions. This empirical evidence will help you determine whether or not the initial assumptions you made were correct and / or which changes you should make.

<u>Watch the recordings of the Workshops:</u> These sessions will support you in identifying the unmet customer needs you want to address and will provide you with an overview of Legal and IP frameworks.

Assignment of Design Thinking Facilitators: One of our biggest success factors of this program - are our Design thinking facilitation sessions that we provide to each team. Facilitators are your main source of inspiration and enabler to guide you in each phase towards getting into your MVP.
